Privacy Notice for Estates (CCTV)

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016

Reasons/purposes for processing CCTV data

GSA processes personal data in the use of CCTV systems to monitor and collect visual images for the purposes of security and the prevention and detection of crime.

We also process sensitive categories of personal data that may include:

- offences and alleged offences
- criminal proceedings, outcomes and sentences

Who the information is processed about

We process personal information about:

- students
- employees, contracted personnel
- suppliers, contractors, professional advisers and consultants
- complainants, enquirers
- persons who may be the subject of an enquiry
- individuals captured by CCTV images

Who the information may be shared with

We sometimes need to share the personal information we process with the individual themselves and also with other organisations. Where this is necessary we are required to comply with all aspects of the GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA). What follows is a description of the types of organisations we may need to share some of the personal information we process with for one or more reasons.

Where necessary or required we share information with:

- police forces,
- security organisations
- courts and tribunals

Your rights

You have the right to request access to, copies of and rectification or erasure of CCTV personal data held by us and to object to processing.

In some circumstance you may have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, to request it is erased where it is no longer required for the stated purposes, or that inaccurate information about you is corrected.
