## English Language Qualifications

Students attending GSA on a Tier 4 visa, who are not a national of, nor have obtained a degree in, one of the countries on the approved exemption list, will need to provide evidence of their English language ability through the use of a standardised test. GSA prefers students to provide one of the test results from List 1, approved as a UKVI SELT. The precise result required will be shown in the student's offer letter.

Students unable to provide a test result from List 1 may consult List 2 (English Language Tests and Qualifications). If students provide a test result from List 2 showing the appropriate level of English for entry onto their chosen programme they will be required to undertake a GSA verification interview. The only exception to this will be students taking the IELTS Academic at an approved testing centre.

## (List 1) UKVI Approved Secure English Language Test (SELT)

Tests taken at an approved testing centre will contain a Unique Reference Number (URN) which allows UKVI to verify results. The URN will be stated on the CAS.
